Please note:

- There are a limited number of spaces reserved in each camp for campers who receive scholarships. We will do our best to honor the camper's top three choices. If for some reason we can't accommodate the top three choices, we will email the camper's guardian and let them select another camp option.



- Scholarship recipient will pay a non-refundable fee. If not paid by March 2, 2020, the spot will be released to another camper.
  - \$7 for one day of Spring Break Camp
- One child can attend one camp with scholarship funds. Guardians are able to apply for scholarships for multiple children. Please fill out a separate application per child.

Applicant criteria:

- Campers must meet the age and grade requirement of the camp.
- Campers must be potty-trained, no pull-ups.
- Campers must be a resident of Marion County.
- To qualify, camper must currently receive free or reduced lunch (or qualify according to federal guidelines) or the family receives public benefits. Provide a written statement from your school office stating eligibility for reduced price or free meals OR show proof of receiving other public benefits. If school provides free lunch to all students, must provide proof of receiving other public benefits.

What is included:

- Each scholarship recipient will include full tuition for one single day camp session for students currently enrolled in kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. After-care is available from 4p-5:30p.
- Lunch, two snacks, and water are included for campers in all-day long programs. Campers can bring their own lunch and snacks if preferred.

To apply:

The camp scholarship application is composed of two parts:

- Part 1: Scholarship Application Form & Guardian Question (application found below)
- Part 2: Demonstration of Financial Need - Please provide evidence of financial need, either an official letter from your school identifying participation in the National School Lunch Program, or proof of other public benefits.
