#### Please note:

- There are a limited number of spaces reserved in each camp for campers who receive scholarships. We will do our best to honor the camper's top choices. If for some reason we can't accommodate the top choices, we will email the camper's guardian and let them select another camp option.
- Scholarship recipient will pay a non-refundable fee of \$7 per day of Fall Break Camp. If not paid by September 25, the spot will be released to another camper.
- One child can attend up 5 days of Fall Break camp with scholarship funds. Guardians are able to apply for scholarships for multiple children. Please fill out a separate application per child.

#### Applicant criteria:

- Campers must meet the age and grade requirement of the camp.
- Campers must be potty-trained (no pull-ups).
- Campers must be a resident of Marion County.
- To qualify, camper must currently receive free or reduced lunch (or qualify according to federal guidelines) or the family currently receives Hoosier Healthwise Insurance, SNAP, or TANF.
- Provide a written statement from your school office stating eligibility for reduced price or free
  meals OR show proof of currently receiving Hoosier Healthwise Insurance, SNAP, or TANF. If
  school provides free lunch to all students, must provide proof of receiving other public benefits.

#### What is included:

- Each scholarship recipient will include full tuition for one single day camp session for students currently enrolled in kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Lunch, two snacks, and water are included for campers in all-day long programs. Campers can bring their own lunch and snacks if preferred.
