



## FAQ

### WHEN WILL THE TRACK BE OPEN?

The track will be open to the public from 10 am – 5 pm on March 30, 31, April 1-3 and 6-10. Please note the track will be closed to the public on April 9 from 10-11:30 am for a private race.

### DO I BRING MY OWN CAR TO RACE DOWN THE TRACK?

You may bring your own car, or use one of the museum's pre-built cars, to race down the track that will be set up in the Great Hall. The museum calls these 'Fun Runs' and will allow Fun Runs the entire time the track is open.

### WHAT'S THE COST TO PARTICIPATE?

The Pinewood Derby track is included with the price of museum admission:

Adults: \$17

Seniors (ages 60 and up): \$16

Youth (ages 3-17): \$12

Children younger than age 3: Free

Boy Scouts with scout ID/uniform: \$7 per family member

Access Pass: \$2 per family member

### WILL THERE BE AN OFFICIAL RACE DAY THIS YEAR?

No, the museum will host Fun Runs only.

### CAN THE TRACK BE RENTED OUT FOR SPECIAL EVENTS?

No. If a group would like to use the track, they simply come to the museum, pay admission and race as they want.

### IS THERE A "BEST IN SHOW" CONTEST?

Yes, the "Best in Show" contest takes place on Saturday, April 9. Visitors wishing to participate in this contest must register and drop off their cars by 2 p.m. on Saturday, April 9. Cars will be displayed and judged during the day on April 9 and winners will be announced/awards presented at 4 p.m.
