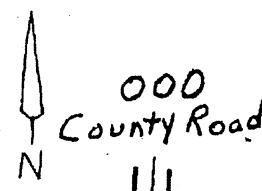
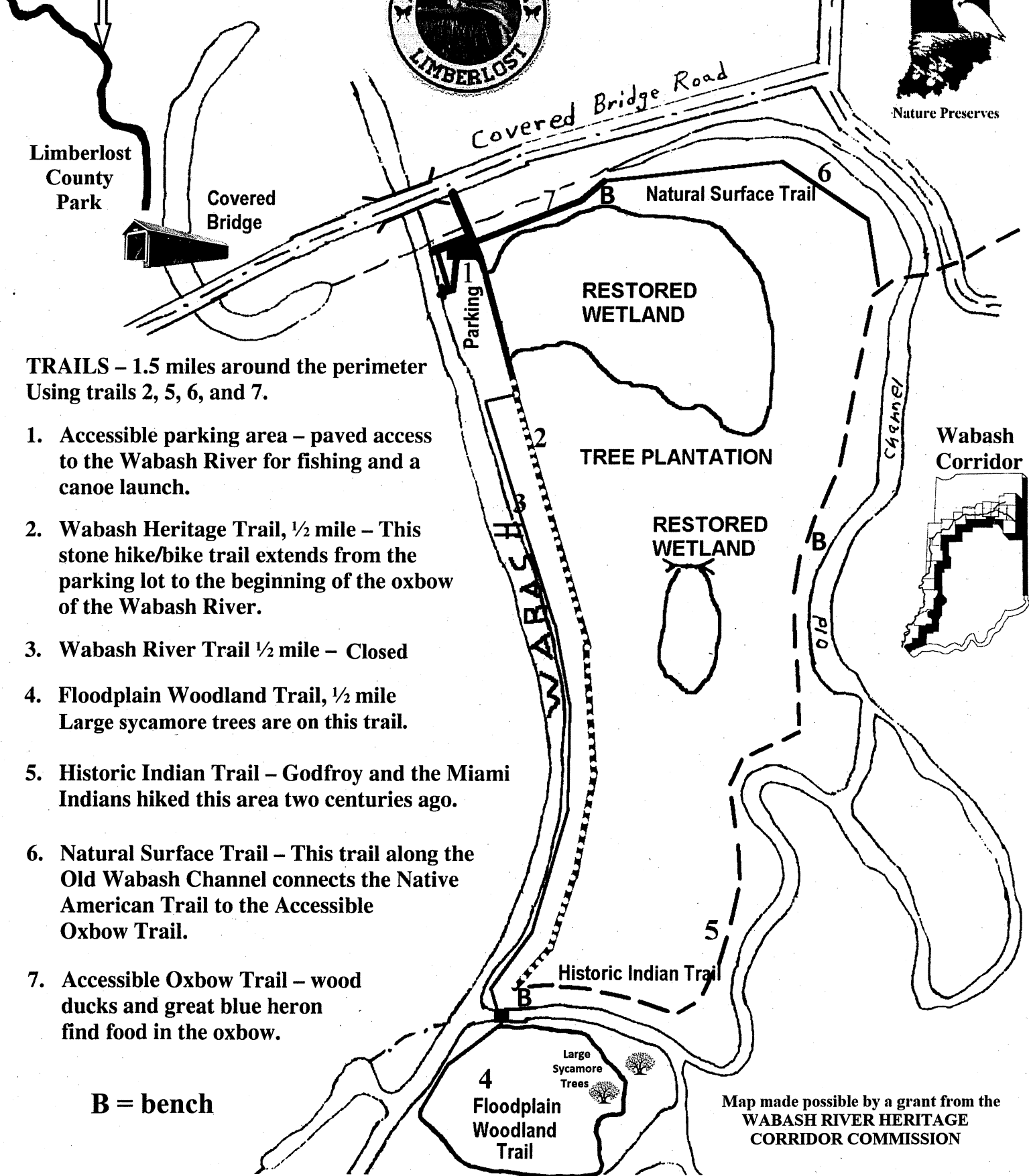


# Wabash River Rainbow Bend Park



Woodland trail connecting to  
Fields Memorial Park, Snow  
Cemetery, the Canoper Trail and  
historic railroad bridges.



**TRAILS** – 1.5 miles around the perimeter  
Using trails 2, 5, 6, and 7.

1. Accessible parking area – paved access to the Wabash River for fishing and a canoe launch.
2. Wabash Heritage Trail, ½ mile – This stone hike/bike trail extends from the parking lot to the beginning of the oxbow of the Wabash River.
3. Wabash River Trail ½ mile – Closed
4. Floodplain Woodland Trail, ½ mile  
Large sycamore trees are on this trail.
5. Historic Indian Trail – Godfroy and the Miami Indians hiked this area two centuries ago.
6. Natural Surface Trail – This trail along the Old Wabash Channel connects the Native American Trail to the Accessible Oxbow Trail.
7. Accessible Oxbow Trail – wood ducks and great blue heron find food in the oxbow.
